CHAINS	South, on the West Bdy. of sec. 18. Va.(lost)
24.18	Set witness cor. from which, A B. oak, 9 ins. diam., bears S.48*E., 48 lks. dist. A Y. pine, 48 ins. diam., bears N.15*W., 16 lks. dist.
28.50	A drain, 8 lks. wide, course SE.
40.00	Set $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. post, from which Va.12*E. A B. oak, 12 ins. diam., bears N.8*W., 320 lks. dist. Made trench as per instructions.
65.00	Enter rich prairie, course E. and W.
80.00	Set post cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, deposited a quart gravel, stone and raised mound with trench, as per instructions. Land, hilly, 2nd rate, covered with grass. Timber, a few scattering oaks.
	South, on the West Bdy. of Sec. 19. Va.19*15'.
9.00	Leave prairie and enter B. oak openings.
32.00	Intersect right bank of Umpqua river and set meander post, from which A W. oak, 12 ins. diam., bears N.12 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E., 27 lks. dist. A W. oak, 15 ins. diam., bears N.26*W., 27 lks. dist.
32.46	Set flag on line near right bank.
36.50	Over river on left bank N.53 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E., 2 chs. base. Flag near right bank bears N.29 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., dist. 4 chs. and 4 lks.
37.50	Set meander post, and make mound of stone, from which A W. oak, 8 ins. diam., bears S.63*E., 238 lks. dist. Stream, very deep and rapid, course S.70*W., low banks, rough rocky bed.
40.00	Set $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. post, from which A B. oak, 18 ins. diam., bears S.28*W., 87 lks. dist. A B. oak, 6 ins. diam., bears N.80*E., 145 lks. dist.
48.30	Bed of slough, course W.
56.80	A trail, course E. and W.
56.80	Leave oak opening and enter prairie. Bottom, course SW.
