


County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Subdivisions and Meanders of Umpqua River in Township 26 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

CHAINS	Va. 18*E.	
	North, on line between 14 & 15.	
20.00	Road, S. W.	
23.00	Enter fir timber.	
30.15	Set meander post on south or left bank of Umpqua River from which, A R. Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.60*W., 13 lks. dist. A R. Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.79*E., 36 lks. dist.	
34.00	Set meander post on north or right bank of Umpqua River, from which, An Alder, 15 ins. diam., bears N.85*E., 50 lks. dist. An Ash, 10 ins. diam., bears N.2*W., 8 lks. dist.	
	Distance across river obtained as follows, Viz. Caused a flag to be placed on line at A, on north bank of river. Measured DB=130 lks. Construct ABC & BCD, right angles, and measured CD=43 lks., then by similarity of triangles, we have,	
		
	43 : 130 :: 130 : 393 393 - 8 = 385 (Place of observation 8 lks., south of meander post.)	
40.00	Set 1/4 Sec. post from which, An Ash, 8 ins. diam., bears S.20*E., 283 lks. dist. A Willow, 4 ins. diam., bears S.23*W., 225 lks. dist.	
59.50	Enclosure of Huntley's pasture, Trail, E. & W.	
80.00	Set post of Secs. 14, 15, 10 & 11, from which, An Ash, 15 ins. diam., bears S.3*E., 640 lks. dist. An Ash, 6 ins. diam., bears S.21*W., 1135 lks. dist. A W.Oak, 10 ins. diam., bears N.3*W., 770 lks. dist.  (no trees convenient N. E.) Land, 1st rate; timber, fir, maple, oak, and ash.	
	East, on random between Secs. 11 & 14.	
40.00	Set temporary 1/4 Sec. post	
44.00	Leave prairie.	+15
66.50	W. side of hill. Va. 19*E.	+150
72.50	Summit of hill. Va. 7*E.	+20
80.00	Intersected N. & S. line, 28 lks. south of post corner of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14, from which, I run,
