44.88	Set $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. post, from which A W. Oak 18 ins. diam. bears S.83°W. 130 lks. A W. Oak 14 ins. diam. bears N.33 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E. 260 lks. Var.17°35'E.	+350
84.88	To Section corner. Land, on W. & N.W. slope of hills West 25 chains rolling prairie in East point of valley. Balance, hilly Oak Openings. Soil, in valley 1st rate, in hills 2nd rate.	+450
	North, between Sections 29 & 30. Var.17°35'E.
