

Meanders of North Fork Umpqua T. 26 S., R. 5 W.

CHAINS

This Township is hilly on the North and South sides and mostly valley in the Center. Laying on both sides of the North Fork of the Umpqua which runs in an easterly though somewhat crooked path through the township. The hills are principally Oak Openings and Prairie generally brushy with Fir Timber on their North sides and in Ravines. Soil generally 2nd and often 3rd rate. Some of the slopes 1st rate. The valley Oak Openings, prairie and rolling and hilly. Soil generally 1st and 2nd rate and considerable of it yet to be taken. There are many small streams that afford plenty of water through the whole year except perhaps two or three months in the fall when they in common with almost all others in this valley dry entirely up or stand in small pools where the water sinks and rises.
