33.52	Intersected left bank of N. Umpqua, and set Meander post from which A Y. Oak 6 ins. diam. bears S.35*W. 5 lks. A ditto 26 ins. diam. bears S.86 $\frac{3}{4}$ *E. 114 lks.	-15
34.42	Set a flag at water's edge, course of river N.20*E., bank low and brushy. Thence over river to a point West of flag. Thence North 977 lks. Thence East 475 lks into line.	
44.19	On right bank and set Meander post, whence A Y. Oak 24 ins. diam. bears N. $\frac{1}{2}$ *E. 114 lks. A ditto 26 ins. diam. bears N.68 $\frac{3}{4}$ *W. 238 lks. Var.19*15'E.	
46.50	George Evan's house bears S.20*W.	
51.00	Leave valley and begin to ascend steep hill, course N.20*E.&S.20*W. A trail, ditto	+20
63.00	Top of steep rocky bluff, course N.20*E.&S.20*W.	+400
75.00	Begin to descend, course N.E.&S.W.	+50
80.00	Set post cor. to Secs. 14,15,22 & 23, from which A Y. Oak 18 ins. diam. bears N.68*E. 70 lks. A W. Oak 12 ins. diam. bears S.76 $\frac{3}{4}$ *E. 60 lks. A ditto 18 ins. diam. bears S.8*W. 336 lks. A Y. Oak 40 ins. diam. bears N.27*W. 312 lks. South of river, nearly level prairie and Oak openings. Soil, good 2nd rate. North of river, Hilly oak openings. Soil, 2nd and 3rd rate.	-80
	S.89*46'E. On random between Secs 14 & 23. Var.17*35'E.	
79.56	Intersect North & South line 13 lks. South of Sec. Corner. N.89*52'W. on true line between Secs. 14 & 23.
