Land, timbered openings, 2nd rate.

Banks high, with thick willow bushes at waters edge.

between secs. 19 and 24, thence up

S.32*W. 5.00 chs.

S.15*W. 10.00 chs., A fence, course E. and W.

S.7*W. 14.00 chs.

Land, mostly prairie, except

Land, low, gravelly and poor. Subject to inundation.
