80.45 Corner to secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.  
Land, 3rd. rate.  
Timber, fir, laurel, hemlock, cedar, dogwood, and maple.  
Undergrowth, vine-maple, laurel and hazel.  
July 22, 1881

North on random bet. secs. 4 and 5.

Va.  $19\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E.

25.20 Stream, 3 lks. wide, course East.

31.25 Stream, 2 lks. wide, course East.

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  post.

80.70 Intersected Northern boundary of township, 90 lks.

East from corner of Secs. 4 and 5, 32 and 33.

Thence I run  $S.0^{\circ}39'E.$  on true line between secs.

4 and 5.

40.70 Set laurel post for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq.,  
from which,

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears  $S.85^{\circ}E.$ , 45 lks. dist.

A cedar, 50 ins. diam., bears  $N.20^{\circ}W.$ , 46 lks. dist.

80.70 Corner to secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.

Land, 2nd. and 3rd. rates.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar chinquapin, and maple.

Undergrowth, same as before described.

North on true line bet. secs. 31 and 32.

Va.  $19\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E.

8.25 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course NE.

10.00 Commenced to ascend ridge.
