CHAINS

The timber is excellent and abundant. The water from streams and springs is plenty and of an excellent quality.

The geological formation is principally of sandstone and conglomerate. Much of the sandstone is good for building purposes, etc.

The west slope of the mountain range is more gradual but is soon broken by sharp spurs and deep canyons, which is the general character of most of the land we have passed over.
