A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.60\*E., 210 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.50\*W., 295 <sup>lks.</sup> chs. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

66.50 Double fir, 30 ins. diam. on line. I mark with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.

80.00 Set a fir, post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26, and 27, marked T 26 S S 23 on NE, R 8 W S 26 on SE, S 27 on SW, and S 22 on NW. faces, with 2 notches on S. and E. edges from which

Destroyed

A fir 12 ins. diam., bears N.35\*W., 135 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 8 W S 22 B T.

Land mountainous\*
