CHAINS

- 45.00 Lake Creek, 10 lks. wide, course W. 900 ft. below sec. cor.
- 57.00 Summit of ridge, course NE. and SW. 150 ft. above creek, thence over nearly level ground.
- 69.00 Descend.
- 80.00 Set a cedar post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22, and 23., 30 ft. below the level ground, marked T 26 S S 14 ON NE, R 8 W S 23 on SE, S 22 on SW, and S 15 on NW. faces, with 3 notches on S. and 2 notches on E. edges, from which
- A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.41*E., 38 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 8 W S 14 B T.
- A white fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.25*E., 46 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 8 W S 23 B T.
- A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.51*W., 42 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 8 W S 22 B T.
- A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.22½*W., 66 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 8 W S 15 B T.
- Land, mountainous.
- Soil, 4th rate.
- Timber, fir, hemlock, and cedar, nearly all dead.
- Undergrowth, balm, willow, briars, and hemlock.
- Mountainous land or land covered with dense undergrowth, 80.00 chs.
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- East on a random line bet. secs. 14 and 23.
- 40.00 Set temp. ¼ sec. cor.
- 80.10 Intersect N. and S. line 10 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23, and 24, thence I run N.89*56'W. on a true line bet. secs. 14 and 23.
- Descend from cor.
- 17.00 A creek, 5 lks. wide, course SW. 100 ft. below sec. cor. Thence ascend
- 40.05 Set a fir post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor. marked ¼ S on N. face from which
