45.25	A fir, 72 ins. diam. on line, I mark with 2 notches on N. and S sides.
63.00	A fir, 48 ins. diam. on line, marked with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.
72.00	Summit of ridge, 500 ft. above Wolf Creek, bears NE. and SE.
79.88	The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10, and 11. Land, mountainous. Soil 3rd rate. Timber, fir, hemlock, and cedar. Undergrowth, laurel, fir, and hemlock. Mountainous land or covered with dense undergrowth for 79.88 Chs. Sept. 25, 1896.

From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33, and 34.
In the S. bdy. of Tp. lat. 43°15' N. long. 123°38'W.
(Supplied) which is a fir post, marked and witnessed as per notes furnished by surveyor general.

40.00	Set yew post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face from which A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.53°E., 115 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. (No trees in limit W. of line) A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.77°E., 125 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
65.00	Callahan Trail, course E. and W. on summit of ridge, 300 ft. above stream; Descend.
74.00	Dry Gulch, 150 ft. below trail, course W.
80.00	Set a yew post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in ground, for cor. to secs. 27, 28, 33, and 34, marked T 26 S S 27 on NE, R 8 W S 34 on SE, S 33 on SW, S 28
