A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.63*E., 60 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 8 W S 34 B T.

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.14*W., 134 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 8 W S 33 B T.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.31*W., 58 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 8 W S 28 B T.
