CHAINS

- 65.50 Summit of ridge, 200 ft. above stream; descend course NE. and SW.
- 79.99 The cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33, and 34, 200 ft. below ridge. Land, mountainous. Soil, 2nd rate. Timber, fir, hemlock, and cedar, mostly dead and fallen. Undergrowth, maple, mountain balm, and arrow-wood. Mountainous land or covered with dense undergrowth for 79.99 chs. Sept. 28, 1896.

- N.0*02'W. bet. secs. 27 and 28. Va.20*16'E.
- Ascend over uneven ground.
- 31.00 To level ground, 150 ft. above cor. Summit bears E. and W.
- 37.50 A stream, course NW.
- 40.00 Set yew post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in ground for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S on W. face, from which A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.64*E., 47 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T. A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.37*W., 50 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.
- 40.50 A stream, course W; ascend.
- 41.50 Summit of spur, 100 ft. above the cor. NW. and SE. Descend.
- 58.00 A stream, course W.200 ft. below the spur; ascend.
- 80.00 Set fir post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for the cor. to secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28. marked T 26 S S 22 on NE, R 8 W S 27 on SE, S 28 on SW, S 21 on NW. faces, with 3 notches on E. and 2 notches on S. edges, from which A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.43*E., 36 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 8 W S 22 B T. A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.40*E., 91 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 8 W S 27 B T. A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.44*W., 40 lks. dist.,
