80.00 Set a fir post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the  
ground, for the cor. to secs. 28, 29, 32, and 33, 300  
ft. below point at 60 chs. marked T 26 S S 28 on NE,  
R 8 W S 33 on SE, S 32 on SW, S 29 on NW. faces, with  
4 notches on E. and 1 on S edges. from which
