	Descend.
17.00	A fir, 48 ins. diam. on line marked with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.
38.00	A stream, 2 lks. wide, course E. 75 ft. below ridge.
40.00	Set a cedar post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S. on W. face, from which A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.25*E., 4 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.20 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 65 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
43.50	Stream, 3 lks. wide, course E.
46.50	A fir, 48 ins. diam. on line marked with 2 notches on the N. and S. sides.
66.50	A stream, 2 lks. wide, course E. Ascend.
72.00	Summit of ridge, 200 ft. above stream, bears E. and W.
80.00	Set a cedar post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in ground, for the cor. to secs. 17, 18, 19, and 20, marked T 26 S S 17 on NE, R 8 W S 20 on SE, S 19 on SW, S 18 on NW. faces, with 3 notches on S. and 5 on E. edges, from which A hemlock, 16 ins. diam., bears N.68*E., 50 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 8 W S 17 B T. A cedar, 10 ins. diam., bears S.62*E., 17 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 8 W S 20 B T. A hemlock, 18 ins. diam., bears S.72*W., 30 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 8 W S 19 B T. A hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears N.70 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W. 22 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 8 W S 18 B T.
	Land, mountainous. Soil 3rd rate. Timber, fir and hemlock, nearly all burned, dead and fallen. Undergrowth of balm, willow, madrona, and myrtle.
