## CHAINS

- 42.00 A ridge, course N. and S. 150 ft. above stream.  
Descend.
- 56.00 A hemlock, 18 ins. diam. on line marked with 2 notches  
on E. and W. sides.
- 80.08 The cor. to secs. 17, 18, 19, and 20.  
Land, mountainous.  
Soil, 2nd rate.  
Timber, fir, hemlock, and cedar, dead fir 1st 40 chs. and  
good for last 40 chs.  
Undergrowth of vinemaple, laurel and hemlock.  
Mountainous land or covered with dense undergrowth,  
for 80.08 chs.  
Oct. 16, 1896.

- 9.00 A hemlock, 24 ins. diam. on line, marked with 2 notches  
on N. and S. sides.
- 40.00 Set a cedar post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in  
the ground, for the  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor. marked  $\frac{1}{2}$  S. on W. face,  
from which  
A cedar 12 ins. diam., bears N.12°E., 26 lks. dist.,  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.  
A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.37°W., 45 lks. dist.,  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.
- 45.00 A fir, 24 ins. diam. on line marked with 2 notches on  
N. and S. sides.
- 54.50 A stream 6 lks. wide, course NE.
- 59.00 Same stream, course NW. 200 ft. below cor.  
Ascend.
- 68.00 Summit of spur, 60 ft. above stream, bears E. and W.  
Descend.
- 80.00 Set a fir post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the  
ground for the cor. to secs. 7, 8, 17, and 18, 250 ft  
below spur, marked T 26 S S 8 on NE, R 8 W S 17 on SE,
