

Resurvey of the E. bdy. of T. 26 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS
80.00 Set cedar post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, marked T 26 S S 30 on NE, R 8 W S 31 on SE, S 36 on SW, and R 9 W S 25 on NW. faces, with 5 notches on N. and 1 notch on S. edges, from which

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.59*E., 163 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 8 W S 30 B T.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.18*E., 61 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 8 W S 31 B T.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S.85*W., 358 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 9 W S 36 B T.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.77*50'W., 358 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 9 W S 25 B T.

From this cor. the old cor. which is almost obliterated by fires, only the charred stumps of the bearing trees remaining; the one on the SE. still showing the letter T on lower blaze; all other marks gone, bears N.49*15' W., 96 lks. dist.
