CHAINS

Land, mountainous; soil, 2nd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, alder and laurel.

Undergrowth, dense.

The S 3.50 chs. through green timber, remainder through old deadening.

Mountainous and heavily timbered land, or land covered with dense undergrowth, 81.87 chs.

At the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35 in the S. bdy. of the Tp. which I established September 4, 1896.

A fir, 32 ins. diam., bears S.38°30'E., 182 lks.	-40
