40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.40 Intersect N & S line 42 lks. S of the cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26.

Thence I run

West, on a true line bet. secs. 23 and 26

7.00 Coos River 120 lks. wide, runs N.5*W. -50

9.00 Ascend hill, bears N & S.

40.20 Set maple post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N face, from which +400
 A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears N.4*45'W., 193 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S, B.T.
 A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears S.22*E., 104 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S, B.T.

55.50 Top of ridge, bears N & S. +650

80.40 The cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27.

Land, mountainous.

Timber, hemlock fir, maple, myrtle, cedar and chincopin.

Undergrowth, dense on East half.

Mountainous and heavily timbered land, or land covered with dense undergrowth, 80.40 chs.

N.0*8'W., bet. secs. 22 and 23.

Var. 19*30'E.

Ascend gentle slope from cor.

4.00 Top of ridge, bears NW & SE +20

30.00 Begin steep descent, bears NE & SW -60
