CHAINS

- Through heavy timber, dense undergrowth.
- 40.00 Set hemlock post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W face, from which
- A fir, 38 ins. diam., bears N.33*W., 69 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S, B.T.
- A fir, 34 ins. diam., bears N.34*E., 39 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S, B.T.
- 54.67 Roseburgh and Coos Bay Trail, bears NE and SW.
- 55.50 Top of ridge, bears E and W. +50
- 72.30 Brook 3 lks. wide, runs W. -300
- 80.00 Set chincopin post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34, marked
- T. 26 S, S 27 on NE,
R. 9 W, S 34 on SE,
S. 33 on SW and
S. 28 on NW faces, with 5 notches on S and 3 notches on E edges, from which +175
- A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N.18*E., 25 lks. dist. marked T. 26 S, R. 9 W, S 27, B.T.
- A chincopin, 7 ins. diam., bears S.43*E., 51 lks. dist. marked T. 26 S, R. 9 W, S 34, B.T.
- A chincopin, 10 ins. diam., bears S.71*45*W., 50 lks. dist. marked T. 26 S, R. 9 W, S 33, B.T.
- A chincopin, 12 ins. diam., bears N.57*30*W., 72 lks. dist. marked T. 26 S, R. 9 W, S 28, B.T.
- Land, mountainous.
- Soil, 2nd rate.
- Timber, fir, hemlock, chincopin and maple.
- Mountainous or heavily timbered land, or land covered with dense undergrowth, 80.00 chs.
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- East, on random line bet. secs. 27 and 34.
- 40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- 80.34 Intersect N and S line 39 lks. S of the cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35.
