

Retracement of West Bdy., Sec. 6, T. 27 S., R. 1 W.

CHAINS

Timber, fir, pine and cedar.

Undergrowth, laurel, willow.

Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered
with dense undergrowth, 84.75 chs.

June 21, 1902.

This Township is uniformly rough and mountainous. The
Township is well watered and well timbered.

North Boundary of T. 27 S., R. 1 W.,
same Deputy and Contract.

I begin at the cor. of Tps. 26 and 27 S., Rs. 1 E. and
1 W.; I run

West, on a random line along the North Bdy., T. 27 S.,
R. 1 W., setting temp. qr. sec. and sec. cors. at inter-
vals of 40.00 chs., and at 470.35 chs. intersect W.
bdy. of Tp. 14.50 chs. South of the cor. of Tps. 26
and 27 S., Rs. 1 and 2 W., which I established June 21,
1902; therefore, I establish a closing cor. for Tps.
26 and 27 S., R. 1 W. at the point of intersection of
the random line with the West bdy. as follows:

Set a basalt stone, 15x12x8 ins., 10 ins. in ground for
closing cor. of Tps. 26 and 27 S., R. 1 W., marked
with C C on W. and with 6 notches on N., E. and S.
edges, from which

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.80°E., 39 lks. dist.
marked T 26 S R 1 W S 31 B T.

A cedar, 28 ins. diam., bears S.62°E., 32 lks. dist.
marked T 27 S R 1 W S 6 B T.

I destroy all marks on the old Tp. cor. referring to Tps.
26 and 27 S., R. 1 W.

July 9, 1902.

At the cor. of Tps. 26 and 27 S., R. 1 W.

Thence I run

East, on a true line bet. secs. 6 and 31.
