39.00	Top of spur.
	Descend.
39.90	Set a basalt stone 12x10x8 ins., 8 ins. in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, from which A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.15*E. 35 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 24 B T. A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.41*W. 32 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 13 B T.
74.85	A spring branch, 5 lks. wide, course N.
79.80	The cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23 & 24. Land, mountainous. Soil, 4th rate. Timber, fir, hemlock, pine and cedar. Undergrowth, laurel & willow. Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth, 79.80 chs.
	N.0*1'W. bet. secs. 13 and 14. Descend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
9.00	Foot of descent.
10.00	Little River, 60 lks. wide, course W.
11.85	Klamath Trail, bears E. & W.
12.50	Begin ascent of mountain, bears E. & W.
26.00	Top of ascent; thence over bench land.
40.00	Set a basalt stone, 12x10x6 ins., 8 ins. in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, from which A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears NE 21 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 13 B T. A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.69*W. 27 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 14 B T.
45.00	Perpendicular cliff, 25 ft. high, bears E. & W. Ascend.
