50.00	Less steep ascent.
80.00	Set basalt stone 18x10x8 ins., 14 ins. in ground for cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13, 14 marked with 4 notches on S. and 1 notch on E. edge, from which A yew, 10 ins. diam., bears N.73*E. 9 lks. dist. marked T 27 S R 1 W S 12 B T. A fir, 34 ins. diam., bears S.30*E. 44 lks. dist. marked T 27 S R 1 W S 13 B T. A hemlock, 18 ins. diam., bears S.69*W. 10 lks. dist. marked T 27 S R 1 W S 14 B T. A hemlock, 18 ins. diam., bears N.32 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W. 40 lks. dist. marked T 27 S R 1 W S 11 B T. Land, mountainous. Soil, stony and 4th rate. Timber, fir, hemlock, pine and yew. Undergrowth, laurel, willow. Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth, 80.00 chs.
