40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.79.60 Intersect the N. bdy. of T. 24 lks. E. of cor. of secs.
1, 2, 35 and 36.

Thence I run

S.0*11'E. on a true line bet. secs. 1 and 2.

Ascend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

17.60 Top of ridge, bears E. and W.

33.00 Enter brushy swamp, bears SE. and NW.

39.60 The point for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. falls in swamp.46.60 South side of swamp on line set a basalt stone, 12x10x6
ins., 8 ins. in ground for W. C. to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor, marked
W C $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, from whichA hemlock, 14 ins. diam., bears N.75*E. 3 lks. dist.
