

Subdivisions of T. 27 S., R. 1 W.

CHAINS

A hemlock, 14 ins. diam., bears S.59*W. 62 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 1 W S 9 B T.

A hemlock, 24 ins. diam., bears N.49*W. 27 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 1 W S 4 B T.

Land, mountainous and rolling.

Soil, 2nd and 3rd rates.

Timber, fir, hemlock, pine, cedar, maple, yew.

Undergrowth, laurel and vine maple.

Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth, 80.00 chs.

S.89*55'E, on a random line bet. secs. 3 and 10.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.00 Intersect N. and S. line 12 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.

Thence I run

West, on a true line bet. secs. 3 and 10.

Over rolling land through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

10.00 Leave heavy timber and enter brush swamp, bears N. & S.

17.00 Leave brush swamp and enter heavy timber, bears N. & S.

27.50 Settler's trail, bears N.75*E. and S.75*W.

29.00 Abrupt descent.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 12x8x6 ins., 8 ins. in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, from which

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.30*E. 35 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 10 B T.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.70*W. 35 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 3 B T.

56.00 A spring branch, 2 lks. wide, course N.

63.25 A spring branch, 2 lks. wide, course N.

Thence along N. slope.
