CHAINS

Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth, 80.00 chs.

East, on a random line bet. secs. 29 and 32.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.40 Intersect N. and S. line 50 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33.

Thence I run

N.89*39'W. on a true line bet. secs. 29 and 32.

Ascend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

5.50 Cross bend of a spring branch, 5 lks. wide, course SE.

40.20 Set a basalt stone, 12x12x8 ins., 8 ins. in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, from which

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears NE. 37 lks. dist.

marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 29 B T.

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.2*W. 30 lks. dist.

marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 32 B T.

Thence along divide.

80.40 The cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, 4th rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, pine and cedar.

Undergrowth, laurel and huckleberry.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

71.17 Intersect W. bdy. line at the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36.

Thence I run

East, on a true line bet. secs. 30 and 31.

Over summit of divide, through scattering timber,
