- A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears North 13 lks. dist. marked  $\frac{1}{2}$  S 30 B T.
- A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.63\*W. 29 lks. dist. marked  $\frac{1}{2}$  S 31 B T.
- 71.17 The cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32.
- Land, mountainous.
- Soil, 4th rate.
- Timber, fir, hemlock, and pine.
- Undergrowth, laurel and willow.
- Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth, 71.17 chs.

- A cedar, 30 ins. diam., bears S.55\*W. 29 lks. dist. marked  $\frac{1}{2}$  S 30 B T.
- 51.25 A spring branch, 3 lks. wide, course N.
- 59.25 Leave spring branch, bears N.30\*E.
- 80.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x8x8 ins., 10 ins. in ground for cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30, marked with 2 notches on S. and 5 notches on E. edges, from which
- A hemlock, 24 ins. diam., bears N.54 $\frac{1}{2}$ \*E. 62 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 1 W S 20 B T.
- A cedar, 14 ins. diam., bears S.31\*E. 53 lks. dist. marked T 27 S R 1 W S 29 B T.
- A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.34\*W. 25 lks. dist. marked T 27 S R 1 W S 30 B T.
