N.89\*45<sup>E</sup>W. on a true line bet. secs. 19 and 30.Descend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth,  
bears SE. and NW.

22.40 A creek, 15 lks. wide, course NE.

Ascend.

30.50 Thence over rolling ground.

31.50 Set a basalt stone, 15x10x5 ins., 10 ins. in ground for
