A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.38°E., 29 lks.

dist., marked S 19 B T.

Land, 3rd rate; mountainous and rocky.

Densely covered with forests of Fir, Cedar and Hemlock with thick undergrowth of Vinemapple, Huckleberry and Hazel.

S.0°21'W., on true line bet. Secs. 19 and 24.

Va. 18°45'E.
