80.00 Set Fir post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the  
ground for standard corner for Secs. 35 and 36,  
marked S C T 27 S R 2 W on N, S 36 on E and S 35  
on W faces, with one notch on E and 5 notches on
