CHAINS

A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.45*E., 30 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 2 W S 4 B T.

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.30*E., 21 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 2 W S 9 B T.

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.80*W., 20 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 2 W S 5 B T.

No tree within limits on SW; raised stone around post. Surface broken and mountainous.

Land, 3rd rate, densely covered with forests of Fir, Hemlock, Cedar and Laurel, with thick undergrowth of Vinemaple, Hazel, Fir, Chinquapin and Live Oak.

North, on Random line bet. Secs. 4 and 5.

7.65 Spring branch 3 lks. wide, course SE.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner.

49.00 Stream 4 lks. wide, course E.

78.00 Spring branch 2 lks. wide, course E.

81.55 Intersect North bdy. of tp. at 35 lks. West from the cor. to Secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33 which is a Cedar post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., firmly set in the ground marked T 26 S R 2 W S 33 on NE, T 27 S R 2 W S 4 on SE, T 27 S R 2 W S 5 on SW, T 26 S R 2 W S 32 on NW faces with 4 notches on the E and 2 notches on W edges, from which

A Cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears N.57*E., 36 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 2 W S 33 B T.

A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.67*E., 28 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 2 W S 4 B T.

A Fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.35*W., 5 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 2 W S 5 B T.

A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.30*W., 13 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 2 W S 32 B T.

41.55 South on true line bet. Secs. 4 and 5. Set Chinquapin post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on E and W faces from which

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.55*E., 10 lks. dist.,
