A Hemlock, 6 ins. diam., bears S.75*E., 55 lks.

dist., marked T 27 S R 2 W S 13 B T.

A Hemlock, 24 ins. diam., bears S.35*W., 37 lks.

dist., marked T 27 S R 2 W S 14 B T.

A W. Fir, 7 ins. diam., bears N.23*W., 41 lks.

dist., marked T 27 S R 2 W S 11 B T.

Land, rolling.

Soil, rocky 3rd and 4th rate.

Timber, Fir, Pine, Cedar and Hemlock.

Undergrowth, young Fir, Vinemaple, Madrone and Hazel.

Heavily timbered land and covered with dense undergrowth. 80.00 chs.

N.0*1'W., on Random line bet. Secs. 11 and 12.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner.

80.71 Intersect E and W line 24 lks. E of cor. of Secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12 as reset by me July 18, 1905.
