32.60 Leave burn; enter heavy timber and brush, bears N & S

41.60 Old Standard $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. which is a post, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General bears N. 41 lks. dist. As this line is badly out of limits and these old Standard cors. will no longer refer to the secs. on the North and do not refer to the secs. on the South, I now change this cor. to an angle point, as follows: Destroy all marks on cor. and mark A P on N face, then cut out all bearing trees and remark, A P B T

The course of this line is N.89°26'W., 41.60 chs.

76.90 Main Ranger trail from Red Butte to Peel P. O. bears NW and SE

82.20 The Standard cor. of secs. 34 and 35 which is a post, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General bears N. 245 lks. dist.
