CHAINS	<p>Derricks cor. for secs. 15, 16, 21 & 22, which I now destroy bears N.7°30'W., 570 lks. dist.</p> <p>Land Mountainous</p> <p>Soil, 1st. and 2nd. rate</p> <p>Timber, heavy Fir, Hemlock, Cedar and Pine.</p> <p>Dense undergrowth, little Fir, Hemlock and Vinemaple</p> <p>Mountainous land, covered with heavy timber and dense undergrowth, exceptionally difficult to survey. 80.00 chs.</p> <p>Sky overcast at noon; lat., observation impossible</p> <p style="text-align: right;">October 18, 1911</p>
40.00	<p>At the cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 & 22</p> <p>East on a random line bet. secs. 15 & 22</p> <p>Set Temp. $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor.</p>
80.08	<p>Intersect North and South line at the cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22 & 23</p> <p>Thence I run</p> <p>West on true line bet. secs. 15 & 22</p> <p>Ascend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth, exceptionally difficult to survey.</p>
4.38	<p>Main trail; Peel to Red Butte, bears North and South</p> <p>Descend ridge, through heavy timber and brush</p>
20.08	<p>Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SW; Ascend</p>
