Mountainous land, covered with heavy timber and dense

undergrowth and exceptionally difficult to survey. 80.08

At this cor. I set off $9^{\circ}46'S.$, on the decl. arc., and observe the sun on the meridian at noon the resulting lat. is $43^{\circ}13'N.$

N. $0^{\circ}02'W.$, bet. secs. 15 & 16

Descend through dense timber and underbrush, exceptionally difficult to survey.

27.10 Branch of Wolf, Creek 15 lks. wide, course NW

Ascend

35.50 Top of ridge, bears E. & W., Descend

38.00 Canyon, course NW

40.00 Set a Fir Post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 16 on W., and 15 on E., faces from which

A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. $14^{\circ}E.$, 35 lks. dist., Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 15 B T

A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S. $36^{\circ}W.$, 16 lks. dist., Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 16 B T

44.80 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course W., Ascend

46.12 Derricks $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., which I now destroy bears W., 15 lks. dist.

49.75 Old Blazed Trail, bears NW and SE

57.50 Top of ridge, bears E & W; Descend

66.90 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course NW; Ascend in heavy timber and brush

75.00 Old Trail, bears NW and SE

80.10 Top of ridge, course NE & SW; main trail, Peel to Red Butte along ridge
