

Extension Survey of Subdivision of T. 27 S., R. 2 W., N.M.

CHAINS

Mountainous land covered with heavy timber and dense undergrowth and exceptionally difficult to survey.
80.00 chs.

East, on a Random line bet. Secs. 16 and 21.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner.

80.25 Intersect the N and S line at the cor. of Secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22.

Thence I run

West, on a true line bet. Secs. 16 and 21.

Ascend ridge, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth; exceptionally difficult to survey.

6.00 Top of ridge, bears N and S.

Descend steep ridge, in heavy timber and brush.

24.70 Creek 4 lks. wide, course N; ascend.

34.25 Top of ridge, bears N and S.

39.25 Derricks $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor., which I now destroy, bears N 625 lks. dist.

40.12 $\frac{1}{2}$ Set a Cedar post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 16 on N and 21 on S faces, from which

A Pine, 28 ins. diam., bears N.18°E., 74 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 16 B T.

A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.88°W., 116 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 21 B T.

70.00 Wolf Creek, 20 lks. wide, course N.

Ascend rocky slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

80.25 The cor. of Secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky and 3rd rate.

Timber, Fir, Hemlock, Cedar and Sugar Pine.

Dense undergrowth of little Fir and Hemlock.

Mountainous land, covered with heavy timber and dense
