Land, on South half of this mile is 2nd rate, North half 3rd rate.

Densely covered with forests of Fir, Cedar, Hemlock and Laurel.

Thick undergrowth of Vine maple and Huckleberry.

- 15.00 Stream, 4 lks. wide, course SW.
- 34.00 Descend mountain.
- 35.00 Enter bottom, (in timber)
- 37.50 East fork N. umpqua, 125 lks. wide, course N.W.
- 40.00 Set Maple post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., firmly in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on E and W. faces, from which
  - A Fir, 14 ins. dia., bears N.15\*W., 8 lks. dis. mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.
  - An Alder, 6 ins. dia., bears S.80\*E., 25 lks. dis. mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T
- 45.00 Leave bottom.
- 80.00 Cor. to secs. 12, 13, 7 and 18, at which a Cedar post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., firmly set in the ground and mkd. T 27 S R 2 W S 7 on NE., R 3 W S 12 on NW., R 3 W S 13 on SW., and S 18 on SE. faces, with 2 notches on N. and 4 on the S. edges, from which
  - A Hemlock, 8 ins. dia., bears N.48\*E., 41 lks. dis. mkd. T 27 S R 2 W S 7 B T.
  - A Hemlock, 8 ins. dia., bears N42\*W., 58 lks. dis. mkd. T 27 S R 3 W S 12 B T.
  - A Fir, 20 ins. dia., bears S.60\*W., 7 lks. dis. mkd. T 27 S R 3 W S 13 B T.
  - A Fir, 30 ins. dia., bears S.58\*E., 59 lks. dis. mkd. T 27 S R 2 W S 18 B T.
