mkd. T 27 S R 3 W S 34 B T.

An Alder, 12 ins. dia., bears S.20°E., 35 lks. dis.  
mkd. T 27 S R 3 W S 35 B T.

Land, 1st rate on the creek bottoms.

Densely covered with forests of Sugar pine, Cedar, Fir and  
Ash, with a thick undergrowth of Vine maple, Huckleberry  
and Hazle.
