Land, 3rd rate.  
Densely covered with forest of Fir, Cedar, Hemlock and thick undergrowth of Vine maple and Hazle.

Va.19\*30'E.

East, on random bet. secs. 16 and 21.  
12.00 Summit of ridge, NW. and SE.  
26.25 Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, course NW.  
40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.  
45.50 Summit of ridge, N. and S.  
74.00 Stream, 3 lks. wide, course SE.  
79.65 Intersect line, 70 lks. S., from cor. to secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22.

A Cedar, 8 ins. dia., bears S.10\*W., 5 lks. dis. mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.  
A Fir, 18 ins. dia., bears N.5\*W., 20 lks. dis. mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.
