Land, 3rd rate.

This mile is cut up with ridges and canyons, and is very rough, densely covered with forests of Fir, Cedar, and Hemlock.

Thick undergrowth of Vine maple, Huckleberry and Balm.

East, on random bet. secs. 20 and 29.

31.70 Stream, 5 lks. wide, course N.

40.00 Set tem.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

61.00 Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, course N.

61.40 Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, course NW.

71.15 Stream, 3 lks. wide, course NW.

79.40 Intersect line, 20 lks. N. from cor. to secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29.

Thence I run

N.89\*51'W., on true line bet. secs. 20 and 29, with same Va.

39.70 Set Laurel post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., firmly in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. mkd.  $\frac{1}{2}$  S on N. and S. faces, from which

A Fir, 12 ins. dia., bears S.45\*E., 15 lks. dis. mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

A Fir, 18 ins. dia., bears N.15\*W., 16 lks. dis. mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

79.40 Cor. to secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30.

This mile is broken into ridges and canyons, densely covered with forests of Fir, Cedar, Hemlock and Pine.

Thick undergrowth of Vine mapel and Balm.
