

Resurvey of E. Bdy. of T. 27 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

CHAINS

A Fir, 32 ins. diam., bears S.6*15'E., 43 lks. dist.
mkd. T 27 S R 3 W S 30 B T.

This cor. is 85 ft. below the summit of Lang^g Mountain.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, light, gravelly loam: 3rd rate.

Timber, Fir and Cedar.

Undergrowth, maple, laurel, snowbrush and salal-berry.

N.0*12'E., resurveying the line bet. secs. 19 and 24.

Descend NW slope through heavy timber and dense
undergrowth.

40.20 Apportioned distance.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in
the ground, for qr. cor. of sec. 19, only, T 27 S, R 3 W.,
with brass cap mkd.

This cor. is 460 ft. below the sec. cor.; continue
descent.

Set a granite stone, 16x12x4 ins., 11 ins. in the
ground for the cor. of secs. 18 and 19, mkd. with
3 notches on N. and S. edges; from which

A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.51*30'E., 36 lks. dist.
mkd. T 27 S R 3 W S 18 B T.
