

## SIXTH STANDARD PARALLEL (NORTH BDY. T. 28 S., R. 5 W.)

CHAINS

Land, all very hilly.

Timber, Fir, Oak, Maple, Laurel, etc.

Undergrowth, Hazel, Oak, Briar, Laurel, Fern, etc.

Soil, 2nd rate.

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West, on North Boundary of Sec. 6.

Va. 18°10'E.

The line here runs into a steep rocky canyon - measured East 13.15 chs. on line and set flag - thence around head of canyon into line on West side - thence measured N. 8°30'E 1250 lks. base. Thence flag on line bears S. 76°40'E. Dis. from flag 54.01 chs.

40.86 across canyon - measured East 86 lks. and

40.00 Set  $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. post, from which

A W. Oak, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 28°W., 80 lks. dist.

A W. Oak, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 35°E., 184 lks. dist.

Va. 19°40'E.

41.00 Top of ridge South and NE; enter prairie same course.

80.00 Set post cor. to Township 28 South and between Ranges

5 and 6 West, from which

A W. Oak, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 628 lks. dist.

A G. Oak, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 85 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 418 lks. dist.

East half in canyon heavily timbered with Fir and dense undergrowth of Hazel, Briar, etc. West half prairie on West slope of hill.

Soil, good, 2nd rate.
