A Y. Oak, 16 ins. diam., bears N.15½°E., 274 lks. dist.

44.00 Leave prairie and enter brushy timber NE and South. -100

53.66 A Pine, 20 ins. diam. -150

63.25 A stream, 2 lks. wide, course NW. -300

76.60 A stream, 2 lks. wide, course NW. -150

78.93 To Standard cor. to Secs. 4 and 5, T. 28 S., R. 5 W. +80

80.00 Corner to Secs. 32 and 33, from which +30

A Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.16°W., 18 lks. dist.

A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.42°E., 8 lks. dist.

Land, all very hilly - East 13 and West 34 chs. timbered with Oak, Fir, Laurel, etc., with a dense undergrowth of Hazel, Oak, Laurel, and balance prairie.

Soil, 2nd and 3rd rate.
