South 23 chs. well timbered with Fir, Cedar, Maple, etc. Undergrowth, Laurel, Hazel, Briar, etc. Balance scattering Oak, Young Oak and Hazel. Soil, 2nd and 3rd rate.

East, on Random between Secs. 28 and 33.
