- 74.00 Intersect right bank Umpqua River and set temporary
Meander post.
Thence over River into line and measured
N.21-3/4°E., 73 lks. base - Thence Meander Post on
right bank bears S.79°E., 377 lks. dist.
Thence West 55 lks. and set temporary Meander post on
left bank.
- 87.15 Intersect West boundary 69 lks. N of Sec. corner.
N.89°30'E On true line between Secs. 18. and 19.
- 8.83 Intersect left Bank of S Fork Umpqua River and set
Meander post, from which
A Willow, 8 ins. diam., bears S.15°E., 20 lks.
dist.
An Ash, 10 ins. diam., bears N.58°E., 29 lks.
dist.
Course of River N.20°E, current gentle.
Bank, sandy and low and brushy.
- 13.15 Set Meander post on left bank, from which
A Thorn, 8 ins. diam., bears S.4°W., 14 lks. dist.
A Thorn, 8 ins. diam., bears N.15°E., 10 lks. dist.
Bank 20 feet high, very brushy.
- 18.86 To Deer Creek, 40 lks. wide, course NW.
- 20.00 Leave brushy timber and enter prairie NW and S.
South about 400lks. to Perry's Flouring Mill being
built.
- 24.75 Road to mines, N and S.
- 25.11 S.42°W., 1017 lks. to a cor. of Perry's claim.
Perry's house bears S.18°E about 8 chs.
A Blacksmith's shop bears S.15°W., 450 lks.
- 37.85 Enter Perry's field, course N.10°E and S.10°W.
- 42.50 Leave fields, S.80°E and N.80°W.
- 47.15 Set 1/4 Sec. post. Drove charned stakes and raised
mound with trench and pits as per instructions.
