South, on West Boundary of Secs. 6, 7, 18, 19, 30 and 31. Set temporary sec. and $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. posts and at 6 miles, 2 chs. and 50 lks., intersect Sixth Standard Parallel 744 lks. West of Standard corner.

Therefore, the correction will be 250 lks. South.

Set post cor. to Tp. 27 S., and between Rs. 6 and 7 W., from which

A Y. Oak, 30 ins. diam., bears N.85 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 560 lks. dist.

Made trench. No other tree near.

40.00 Set $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. post. Drove charred stake and raised mound with trench and pits.

80.00 Set post cor. to Secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36. Drove charred stake and raised mound with trench and pits, as per instructions.

Land, all level prairie in Looking Glass Valley.

35.00 Leave Valley and begin to ascend Hill, NE and SW. +20

40.00 Set $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. post, from which +50

A Y. Oak, 22 ins. diam., bears N.22°E., 242 lks. dist.

42.00 Leave Prairie and enter Oak openings, NE and SW.

45.70 A Stream, 2 lks. wide, course SE. -20

69.12 A Y. Oak, 30 ins. diam. +250
