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## Subdivisions of T. 27 S., R. 6 W.

CHAINS	
	Thence flag bears S.34 $\frac{3}{4}$ *W. Distance across river, 535 lks.
28.85	Set temp. meander post on right bank.
39.11	Intersect right bank of S. Umpqua and set temp. meander post. Thence, N.33 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E., 295 lks. base. Set flag. Thence over river to a point North of post. Thence, flag bears N.32 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W. Distance 500 lks.
44.11	Set temp. meander post on left bank.
82.35	Intersect North boundary 4 lks. West of post. S.1*2'W., on True line between Secs. 5 and 6.
35.00	Leave prairie and enter low brushy bottom, NE. and SW.
38.24	Intersect left bank of S. Umpqua River. Set meander post, from which A Balm of Gilead, 18 ins. diam., bears N.25*E. 76 lks. dist. A Balm of Gilead, 6 ins. diam., bears N.16*W., 74 lks. dist. Course of river, N.50*E., Banks low and sandy.
43.24	Set meander post on right bank, from which A Balm of Gilead, 15 ins. diam., bears S.47*E., 110 lks. dist. A Balm of Gilead, 8 ins. diam., bears S.6 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 115 lks. dist.
53.50	Intersect right bank of S. Umpqua. Set meander post, from which A Balm, 12 ins. diam., bears S.81*E., 66 lks. A Balm, 8 ins. diam., bears N.11*W., 86 lks. Course of river, N.30*W. Bank, low and sandy.
59.20	Set meander post on left bank, from which A Maple, 20 ins. diam., bears S.18*E., 45 lks. A Myrtle, 12 ins. diam., bears S.39*W., 43 lks.
