## CHAINS

branch, post gone where I set new post 3 ft. long, 4 ins. Sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. to Secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, marked

T. 27 S. S. 30 on NE.

R. 7 W. S. 31 on SE.

S. 36 on SW. and

R. 8 W. 6.25 on NW. faces, with 1 notch on South and 5 notches on North edges, from which the original witness trees bear as follows:

A Laurel, 20 ins. diam., bears N.56\*W., 6 lks. dist. (marking overgrown).

A Laurel, 10 ins. diam., bears N.1\*15'E., 100 lks. dist. (marking overgrown).

A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.18\*E., 43 lks. dist., marked T.27 S. R. 7 W., S. 31 B.T.

A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.12\*W., 57 lks. dist. marked T.27 S., R 8 W., S. 36 B.T.

This line runs N. 7\* W.

A retracement of the South Bdy. of Sec. 36 is deemed unnecessary, it having been retraced by me in retracing the Sixth Standard Parallel South, through this Range (R.8W.) and setting cor. for T. 27 S.,R. 8 W.
