48.20 Stream, 5 lks. wide, course NW. Falls of Creek, 2 lks.
left of line.

55.50 Spring branch, course N.

71.00 Spring, on right of line, 50 lks. dist.

73.00 Creek, 15 lks. wide, course NE.

78.00 Stream, 3 lks. wide, course E. 350 below ridge. Ascend.

80.00 Set yew post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the
ground, for cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, marked
T 27 S S 18 on NE, R 8 W S 19 on SE, S 24 on SW, and
R 9 W S 13 on NW. faces, with 3 notches on N. and S.
edges, from which
