

Subdivisions T. 27 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

62.23 Branch 2 lks. wide, course E. 50 ft. below spur; ascend.

80.13 Intersect at a point 16 lks. E. from where I establish the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, 200 ft. above branch, post gone, where I set new post 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, marked T 27 S S 30 on NE., R 7 W S 31 on SE., S 36 on SW., and R 8 W S 25 on NW. faces, with 1 notch on S. and 5 notches on N. edges; from which the original witness trees bear as follows:

A laurel, 20 ins. diam., bears N.56*W., 6 lks. dist. (marking overgrown)

A laurel, 10 ins. diam., bears N.1*15'E., 100 lks. dist. (marking overgrown)

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.18*E., 43 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 7 W S 31 B T.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.12*W., 57 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 8 W S 36 B T.

This line runs N.7'W.

A retracement of the S. bdy. of sec. 36 is deemed unnecessary, it having been retraced by me in retracing the 6th Standard Parallel South, through this range (R 8 W) and setting cor. for T 27 S R 8 W.

Note: No chance to take Latitude this day on account of smoke from fires N. of this station.

From the cor. of secs. 35 and 36 on the S. bdy. of the Tp. described in retracement of Std. Parallel. I run N.0*1'W. bet secs. 35 and 36.

Va.20*14'E.

Ascend from cor.

2.60 Offset W. 80 lks. to avoid rocks.

15.00 Offset back to line.

40.06 Top of Coast Range Mountains NE. and SW. Set a yew post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on W. face; from which
